35th annual Capitol Bible Reading Marathon

What is the difference between coaching and discipleship? "Discipleship involves helping others grow spiritually and engage in the mission. And as coaches we do a lot of discipleship. The key difference is that our coaching work is about helping others launch and lead Cru groups." "We invest in leaders who are actively working to establish and grow Cru ministries on their campus. But coaches are specifically investing in leaders committed to establishing new or stronger Cru ministries on their campus. Presently, The Coaching Center is providing this support for 165 college campuses."

Religious Freedom Collides with Woke Agenda

A Washington couple is challenging state officials after they were barred from serving as respite caregivers due to their religious beliefs about human sexuality.

In August 2022, Shane and Jennifer DeGross worked with foster-care licensing agency Olive Crest to renew their license to provide a home to vulnerable children. The agency informed them that the Washington Department of Children, Youth, and Families enacted <u>new regulations</u> that require all foster parents to use a foster child's inaccurate pronouns based on their perceived gender identity, not their actual sex. The regulations also require that parents take children to cultural events like pride parades. Because of their Christian faith, the DeGrosses told Olive Crest they would love and support any child placed in their home but could not lie to a child about who they are or encourage a child to reject their sex. DCYF officials then denied their application, even after Olive Crest made more than one attempt to appeal the denial.
