### CHURCH ALLIANCE

The U.S. Supreme Court granted review in an ADF case challenging the FDA's removal of key safeguards for chemical abortion drugs.

By removing those safeguards, the FDA expressly authorized unmanaged, unsupervised mail-order abortions—with no doctor involvement required. The agency stitched together a national abortion-by-mail scheme aimed at flooding all 50 states with chemical abortion drugs—undermining the practical effect of the Supreme Court's subsequent ruling in *Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization* that overturned *Roe v. Wade*.

ADF attorneys will argue the case at the Supreme Court sometime in the spring of 2024.

The Church & Ministry Alliance is developing resources to help you understand and share with others about the widespread misinformation surrounding the safety of chemical abortion drugs.

- 3. To continue moving in the lives of the students and volunteers who are taking steps of faith to lead campus ministries across the country.


