April 19th we received a letter from Aimee Huber (Exec Dir) of First Choice which is copied in part here: "This year's Baby Bottle Boomerang is wrapping up and I am thrilled to share that your church raised \$765.50 to help accomplish our mission of protecting the unborn by empowering women! We are so grateful for your support and count your partnership as a gift from God. ...The overall total is \$126,772.13 raised so far, saving 90 babies! ...So far, we know of 686 babies whose moms chose life as a result of coming to us in 2023. We are so grateful to have had a front seat to watching God work in their lives!"

In contrast: The Charlotte Lozier Institute, a pro-life research organization, analyzed Planned Parenthood's new "Above & Beyond" annual report and publicized the following: "Planned Parenthood performed 392,715 abortions in 2021-22...abortions made up 97.1% of Planned Parenthood's pregnancy resolution services."



Memorial Day was originally known as Decoration Day, starting with the American Civil War. It's believed that the tradition of honoring the dead was inspired by the way Southern states decorated the graves of both Confederate and Union soldiers. In 1971, Memorial Day became a national holiday by an act of Congress.

In the war-torn battlefields of Europe, the common red field poppy was one of the first plants to reappear. It's seeds scattered in the wind and sat dormant in the ground, only germinating when the ground was disturbed—as it was by the very brutal fighting of World War 1. Today, poppies are not only a symbol of the loss of life but also of recovery and new life, especially in support of the servicemen who survived the war but suffered from physical and psychological injuries long after it ended.

Some veterans find it dismaying when they are thanked on this day because it's a time to remember those who lost their lives and could not come home.

We thank the men and women who paid the ultimate price and will always remember the sacrifices of our military.
