Daylight Savings Time Ends—Standard Time Begins

Sunday, November 6

Turn your clocks **BACK** Sunday morning at 2:00 AM!
(OR Saturday night before you go to bed!!)



Reminder: change the batteries in your smoke alarms
when you turn your clocks back.

Did you know??

In March, the Senate unanimously passed the "Sunshine Protection Act", which would end Standard Time. The bill now sits in the House of Representatives. "The biannual transition of 'spring forward' and 'fall back' disrupts circadian sleeping patterns, causing confusion, sleep disturbances and even an elevated risk to heart health," according to Senator Marco Rubio.

Federal law doesn't currently allow full-time Daylight Savings Time, so Congress would have to act before any state could make a change. But 19 states -- Alabama, California, Colorado, Delaware, Florida, Idaho, Georgia, Louisiana, Maine, Minnesota, Mississippi, Montana, Ohio, Oregon, South Carolina, Tennessee, Utah, Washington and Wyoming -- have passed legislation or resolutions to stay on daylight saving time permanently, should Congress allow it.
